ontinuing his criticism of the judiciary for its "overreach", Finance Minister Arun Jaitley on Monday said it must draw its own "Lakshman rekha" as there cannot be a "compromise" with other aspects of the basic structure in the name of independence of the judiciary.

Four days after Jaitley said in Parliament that "Step by step, brick by brick, the edifice of India's legislature is being destroyed" due to judicial activism, Jaitley said activism has to be blended with restraint.

"Judicial review is legitimate domain of judiciary but then the Lakshman rekha has to be drawn by all the institutions themselves," Jaitley said, asserting that "the executive decisions are to be taken by the executive and not the judiciary".
